- **"Blues-woman" Lori Davidson** confidently sings her way through several states of blues with a sultry, sexy feel. A San Francisco native, Lori has performed across much of the United States and Canada with artists including Harvey Mandel, John Lee Hooker, Ernest "Boom" Carter, Ken Embrey and Daniel Castro.
- **Archie Lee Hooker, Jr.** recalls the melodies, attitudes and roots of life with his songs. Each one tells a story full of feeling and emotion. When listeners' hear him they understand his roots, the life he has lived and where he is now.
